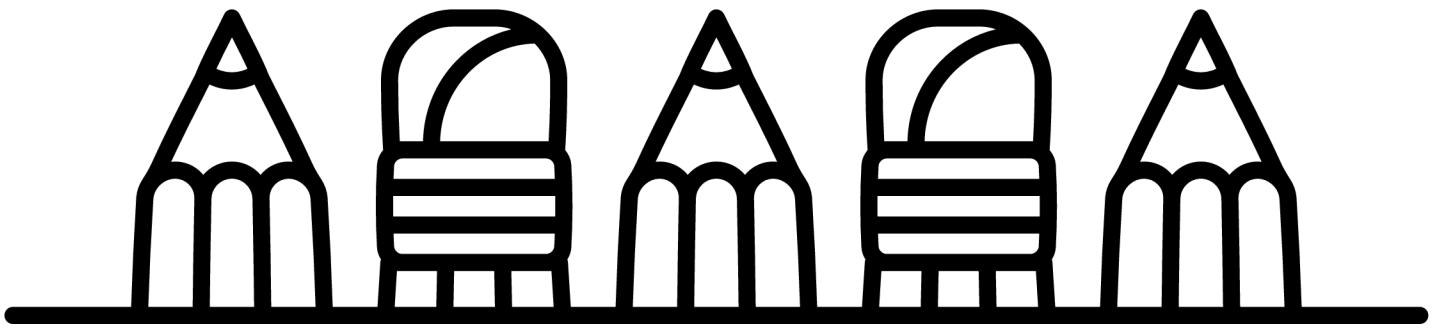




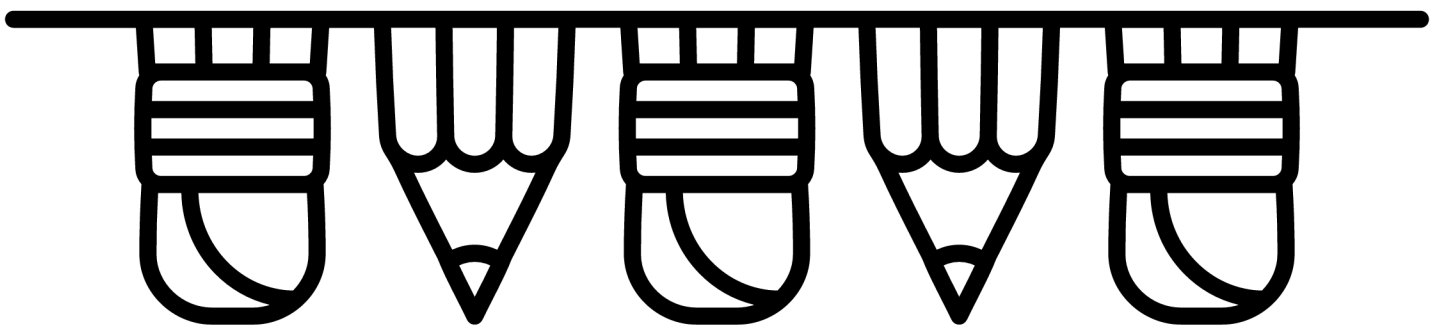

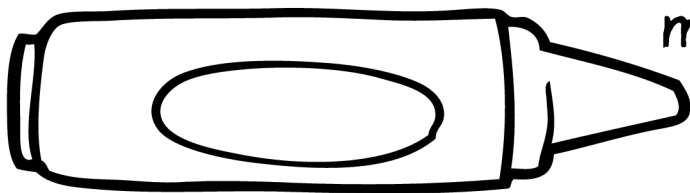
- Read *Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs* by Judi Barrett.
